

# *Hesper Beach Club Rules and Regulations*

---

**Article 1:** Access to the premises of *Hesper Beach Club* is reserved for the elementary school classes of the Commune of Hesperange, for childcare and nursery facilities of the Commune of Hesperange as well as for its residents.

All persons who enter the premises of *Hesper Beach Club* accept, without reservation, the present rules as well as any additions or revocations thereof, in the form of notices, posters or otherwise, located in whatsoever section of the club premises, of which they form an integral part.

All persons shall comply with the instructions and directives of the staff of the establishment.

**Article 2:** The Facilities of *Hesper Beach Club* are open to the public on dates and times determined by the Municipal Executive. Entry to *Hesper Beach Club* is free of charge.

Notwithstanding that the Municipal Executive reserves the right to change its timetables for technical or other reasons, access to the pool will, in any case, be prohibited when meteorological conditions so require (gale, thunderstorm, ...).

**Article 3:** Access to the pool is prohibited:

- by persons affected by contagious diseases or any other infections or illnesses that entail formal medical intervention,
- by persons affected by any confirmed skin lesions or complaints,
- by persons appearing to be in an apparent state of un-cleanliness,
- by persons under the influence of alcohol,
- by persons under the influence of psychoactive substances,
- by children under the age of 6 years unaccompanied by an adult,
- by members of groups unaccompanied by a person in charge.

No animals are allowed on the premises of *Hesper Beach Club*.

**Article 4:** It is forbidden to picnic on the tables provided for the benefit of the users of *Hesper Beach Club*.

Users must shower before entering the pool.

Bathers must wear swimsuits. The wearing of swimming caps is not obligatory.

For reasons of health and safety, it is prohibited:

- to jump into the pool from the poolside;
- to push or throw someone in the pool;

- to run around the pool;
- to eat or drink in close proximity to the pool;
- to damage the facilities or soil the water in any manner whatsoever;
- to espouse improper or immoral behaviour or make any such remark;
- to bring or use any glass objects within the surroundings, other than in the bar.
- to bring play material (balls, blow-up mattresses, floating vehicles, ...) in the pool without the permission of the lifeguard or the supervising staff;
- to chew chewing gum in or around the pool;
- to take photographs, other than with the permission of the person being photographed.

**Article 5:** The pool is under constant surveillance by guards authorised to take any measures necessary to ensure safety.

Users shall comply with orders and directives of the staff in charge of the site.

In general, any case of misconduct or breach of the aforementioned is punishable by expulsion or temporary or permanent exclusion from the club premises. Any behaviour contrary to safety, hygiene, respect of people and places, and propriety will lead to immediate expulsion from the premises of *Hesper Beach Club*.

In case of repeat offending, the trouble-maker will be asked to immediately leave the premises. The person in charge of supervision shall inform the Municipal Executive of the case.

**Article 6:** Persons in charge whether from the Hesperange Municipal Administration or Office of Tourism will not be held responsible in case of non-compliance with the above rules of conduct.

**Article 7:** Users are financially responsible for any damage to the facilities that might be caused by their actions.

The Municipal Administration of Hesperange and the Office of Tourism disclaim all responsibility in cases of theft, loss or damage to objects on the premises of *Hesper Beach Club*.

**Article 8:** Any cases unforeseen in the present regulations fall under the jurisdiction of the Municipal Executive.

Supervising and management staff are in charge of ensuring strict compliance with the present directives.
